FALCONS AGREE TO TERMS WITH OL JUSTIN MCCRAY

The Falcons have agreed to terms on a one-year contract with offensive lineman Justin McCray.

Last season, McCray played in 15 games with four starts at guard for the Cleveland Browns. The four-year vet blocked for an offense that helped Pro Bowler Nick Chubb rush for a career-high 1,494 yards on 298 carries and eight touchdowns.

The UCF alum originally signed with the Tennessee Titans as an undrafted free agent in 2014. Since then, he has spent time with the Arena Football League, Green Bay Packers and Cleveland Browns. McCray has seen action in 40 career games with 17 starts.

FALCONS AGREE TO TERMS WITH FULLBACK KEITH SMITH

The Falcons have agreed to terms with fullback Keith Smith on a three-year extension.

The six-year pro signed with the Atlanta Falcons on Sept. 2, 2019. Last season, Smith saw action in 16 games with five starts and led the team with eight special teams tackles and two special teams forced fumbles.

Smith was originally signed by the Dallas Cowboys as an undrafted free agent linebacker in 2014. At the end of the 2015 season, the San Jose State alum converted into a fullback based on his work with the scout team. He earned the starting position for the Cowboys for the 2016 and 2017 seasons. Smith was signed by the Oakland Raiders on March 15, 2018 as a restricted free agent. In four seasons as a fullback, Smith has rushed eight times for 13 yards and caught 14 receptions for 82 yards.

FALCONS SIGN S SHARROD NEASMAN

The Falcons have signed safety Sharrod Neasman on a one-year contract.

Last season, Neasman saw action in 15 games and registered four special teams tackles. He recovered a blocked PAT during a Week 12 matchup against Tampa Bay. This was the Falcons' first blocked point after a touchdown since December 4, 2016 against Kansas City.

Neasman originally joined the Falcons as a college free agent following the 2016 draft out of Florida Atlantic. Neasman spent the first six weeks of his rookie season as a member of the Falcons practice squad before being called up to the active roster. He spent time with the New Orleans Saints before being resigned by the Falcons in 2018.

He has played in 41 career games, recording 45 tackles (29 solo), two tackles for loss, three special teams tackles and four passes defensed.
